

# Heiltsuk Unicode Keyboard Mac User Guide

This guide will show you exactly how to type each letter available in the Heiltsuk keyboard.

## Letters typed with only one key

Refer to the Heiltsuk Keyboard Images Mac.pdf file in the folder for a visual reference

λ : this letter can be used by typing the [ key on your keyboard

λ̇ : this letter can be used by typing the ] key on your keyboard

ł : this letter can be used by typing the \ key on your keyboard

ḣ : this letter can be used by typing the ` key on your keyboard

## Letters typed by combining Shift + other keys

Refer to the Heiltsuk Keyboard Images Mac.pdf file in the folder for a visual reference

Ł : this letter can be used by typing the \ key on your keyboard *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + \)*

Ḣ : this letter can be used by typing the ~ key on your keyboard *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + ~)*

λ̇ : this letter can be used by typing the [ key on your keyboard *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + [)*

á : this accent will combine with any letter that comes before it, so to type á, you would need to type a and then type - *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + -)*

ǰ : this symbol will combine with any letter that comes before it, so to type ǰ you would need to type x and then type 6 ***while holding down the Shift key (Shift + 6)***

k' : this symbol will attach onto any letter that comes before it, so to type k', you would need to type k and then type , ***while holding down the Shift key (Shift + ,)***

## Letters typed by combining Option/Alt + other keys

Refer to the Heiltsuk Keyboard Images Mac.pdf file in the folder for a visual reference

à : this accent will combine with any vowel that comes before it, so to type à, you would need to hold down the Option/Alt key and type ~ and then type a (**Option/Alt + ~**)

ṡ : this symbol is typed by holding down the Option/Alt key and typing m (**Option/Alt + m**)

ł : this symbol is typed by holding down Option/Alt key and typing l (**Option/Alt + l**)

ņ : this symbol is typed by holding down Option/Alt key and typing n (**Option/Alt + n**)

ʔ : this symbol is typed by holding down Option/Alt key and typing ? (**Option/Alt + ?**)
