

Installing Mac format Key-layouts

These keyboard layouts require Mac OS 10.2 or higher.

Mac keyboard layout installation procedure

1. In the Finder on the top of your screen, choose Go > Computer or type Shift-Command-C. This opens up your account folder.
2. Expand the Macintosh HD folder (i.e. OS_X), then the Library folder.
3. Scroll down to find "Keyboard Layouts" and open this folder.
4. Copy (cmd+c) keyboard layout file (Heiltsuk Orthography.keylayout) and paste (cmd+v) into this folder.
5. Log off (apple icon top left > Log off) or restart (apple icon top left > restart) the computer.

Once your computer has rebooted...

If you have a Mac OS version earlier than 10.9.1 Mavericks, follow step 6.

If you have OS 10.9.1 Mavericks or later, skip to step 7.

6.
 - a) Open System Preferences > Language and Region. Click the Input Sources tab.
 - b) Scroll down until you find the name of the keyboard layout you just installed (Heiltsuk). Make sure the checkbox is selected.

The layout is now ready to use.

Or

7.
 - a) Open System Preferences > Language and Region. Click the Keyboard Preferences button at the bottom.
 - b) Click the + (plus) sign at the bottom left to add a keyboard layout.
 - c) Select Others in the left-side pane, this should display a list of keyboard layouts

which includes the one you just installed (Heiltsuk). Select the keyboard you want and click add.

(Don't worry if the message says Keyboard layout not available - just ignore this)

The layout is now ready to use.

Using your new Heiltsuk Mac keyboard

To access the key layout, click on the flag at the top of your screen. Select the keyboard layout called Heiltsuk from the list.
