

# Heiltsuk Unicode Keyboard Windows User Guide

This guide will show you exactly how to type each letter available in the Heiltsuk keyboard.

## Letters typed with only one key

Refer to the *Heiltsuk.jpg* file in the folder for a visual reference

λ : this letter can be used by typing the [ key on your keyboard

λ̈ : this letter can be used by typing the ] key on your keyboard

ł : this letter can be used by typing the \ key on your keyboard

ḧ : this letter can be used by typing the ` key on your keyboard

## Letters typed by combining **Shift** + other keys

Refer to the *HeiltsukShift.jpg* file in the folder for a visual reference

Ł : this letter can be used by typing the \ key on your keyboard *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + \)*

Ĥ : this letter can be used by typing the ~ key on your keyboard *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + ~)*

Λ : this letter can be used by typing the [ key on your keyboard *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + [)*

á : this accent will combine with any letter that comes before it, so to type á, you would need to type a and then type - *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + -)*

â : this accent will combine with any letter that comes before it, so to type â, you would need to type a and then type + or = *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + +/=)*

ǰ : this symbol will combine with any letter that comes before it, so to type ǰ you would need to type x and then type 6 *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + 6)*

k' : this symbol will attach onto any letter that comes before it, so to type k', you would

need to type k and then type , *while holding down the Shift key (Shift + ,)*

Letters typed by combining **Ctrl/Alt/Shift** + other keys

**ᓄ** : this symbol is typed by holding down **Ctrl/Alt/Shift** keys and typing **m**

**ᓂ** : this symbol is typed by holding down **Ctrl/Alt/Shift** keys and typing **l**

**ᓃ** : this symbol is typed by holding down **Ctrl/Alt/Shift** keys and typing **n**

**ᓄ** : this symbol is typed by holding down **Ctrl/Alt/Shift** keys and typing **?**
